

Notes in addition to the presentation slides shown.

Saturday – Middle distance

Q: Where is a refreshment control placed?

A: It is on a control point. It is also mentioned in the control descriptions.

Q: How long can coaches stay with the competitors before the start?

A: Coaches can stay with the competitors until the -15 Minutes corridor (15 Minutes to the start).

Q: Is the warm-up map relevant for the terrain type of the competition?

A: The terrain type is relevant, but it doesn't involve any larger rocks, that are specific for the competition area.

Q: What is a size of the warm-up map?

A: A standard-sized warm up map as known for another competitions. Large enough for a warm up.

Q: When the start bibs will be handed over?

A: You can pick them up in the event office right after this meeting.

Q: When the start list will be published?

A: The start list will be published on the internet in about an hour after the meeting.

Sunday – Sprint

Q: The course will be printed out on the both sides of the map. What side of the map will runners see, when they receive it at their start time?

A: It will be the first part.

Q: When does the B-finals runners go to the quarantine?

A: There is no quarantine for the B-finals runners.

Q: When can the B-finals runners go to their start?

A: They are allowed to leave the competition center after the start time of the last runner of the A-finals at earliest.

Q: What is the description of a surface in the competition area?

A: The competition takes place in an urban area. Therefore the most of the area is covered with asphalt (around 75%).

Q: Will the B-finals have a start list?

A: Yes, it will be published as for any other competition.

General

Q: Will the overall World Cup ceremony take place on Sunday?

A: Yes, the podium ceremony for the top placed runners will take place, but full official overall results will be published later.
